2. **Minutes of Last Meeting**

5. **County Council Update from Liam Walker**
 - Liam is investigating why Crawley has a 7.5ton weight restriction on entry to the village from Leafield, but not from the other direction.
 - He will raise again with the cabinet member a weight restriction with Crawley. Members were asked to continue to send photographs of inappropriate vehicles navigating around the village.
 - Foxburrow Lane – Liam will investigate replacing the passing place and single track signs for Foxburrow Lane, which has become extremely difficult and dangerous to negotiate.
6. **Treasurer's Report**
 - £351 grass cutting grant has been received from the County Council.

- It was voted by a majority to donate £50 to the South Central Ambulance Service (2 for, 1 against, 1 abstain).
