

The Parish Council has received good news of progress on the scheme to get 20mph speed limits in Oxfordshire towns and villages where vehicles mix with pedestrians and cyclists.

- In December 2020 Oxfordshire County Council made a unanimous decision to support the Oxfordshire 20mph campaign.
- A budget of £200,000 has now been allocated to the project.
- OCC will appoint a leader to create a project group. The group will include stakeholders such as 20's Plenty for Oxfordshire.
- OCC will need the support of villages, towns, and the local communities to help with creating a social consensus for 20mph.
- 20's Plenty for Oxfordshire strongly urge us to support OCC and communicate the message that 20mph should be recognised as the speed limit in our village even before it becomes mandatory.
